There has been a theft of a vehicle and two shed burglaries in Meaford.

The incidents occurred sometime overnight Monday 17 October/Tuesday 18 October when offenders stole a large quantity of gardening tools from sheds and garages of two properties which, it is believed, were taken away in a green Mitsubishi pick up which had been stolen from a neighbouring property.

For OSWESTRY.

Robbery.

At 7.15pm on Sun 16 October, two males in dark clothes, black gloves, balaclavas and motor cycle helmets, entered a Co-op store in Castle Street, Oswestry . One male carried a carving knife and the other had a machete. These were used to threaten staff. Cash was taken from two tills and tobacco was taken from near a basket bay.

The male with the machete was described as 5?5? tall, probably between 18-20 years old and speaking with a local accent. The other male was 6?? tall and slim. Both ran off towards Castlefields. (OIS incident reference number 0600s 161016).

For SOUTH SHROPSHIRE.

Burglaries.

Between midnight and 8.30am on Tues 18 October, a detached garage off **Hope Baggot Lane, Knowbury**, was raided. Two motor bikes were stolen ? a red Harley Davidson ?Superglide? Theft of a Trailer.

Arson / Fire Incident of Doubtful Origin.

Around 4.30/4.45am on Sun 16 October, approximately 500/700 bales of straw were set alight in two separate locations between **Berwick Wharf and Upton Magna**. Arson is suspected. (OIS incident 0135s 161016).

Thefts From Motor Vehicles.

Around 9pm on Fri 14 October, a van in **Crowmere Road**, was broken into and carpenter?s power tools were stolen. A young witness saw boxes being removed and loaded into a dark coloured vehicle. (OIS incident reference 0764s 141016).

At 9.45pm on Fri 14 October, a van in **Monkmoor Avenue** was broken into and two

Dewalt power drills were removed. Two figures in dark coloured waterproof tops were seen in the driveway at the time. (OIS incident 0137s 151016).

Overnight, between Fri/Sat 14-15 October, a works van in a driveway in **Monkmoor Road**. was attacked and a power drill and a nail gun were taken. (OIS incident 0365s 151016).

Between 6pm Fri/12noon Sat 14-15 October, a van in **Brightwell, off Whitehart, Sutton Park**, was raided. A large quantity of power tools including drills, saws, routers, nail guns and a planer were stolen. (OIS incident reference 0286s 151016).

Suspected Attempted Theft of a Horse.

Between 10am/5pm Thurs 13 October, a Cremello Palomina mare was removed from a field at Duddleston Heath, Ellesmere. It was later recovered from a field some distance away. (OIS incident reference 0610s 131016).

Burglaries.
